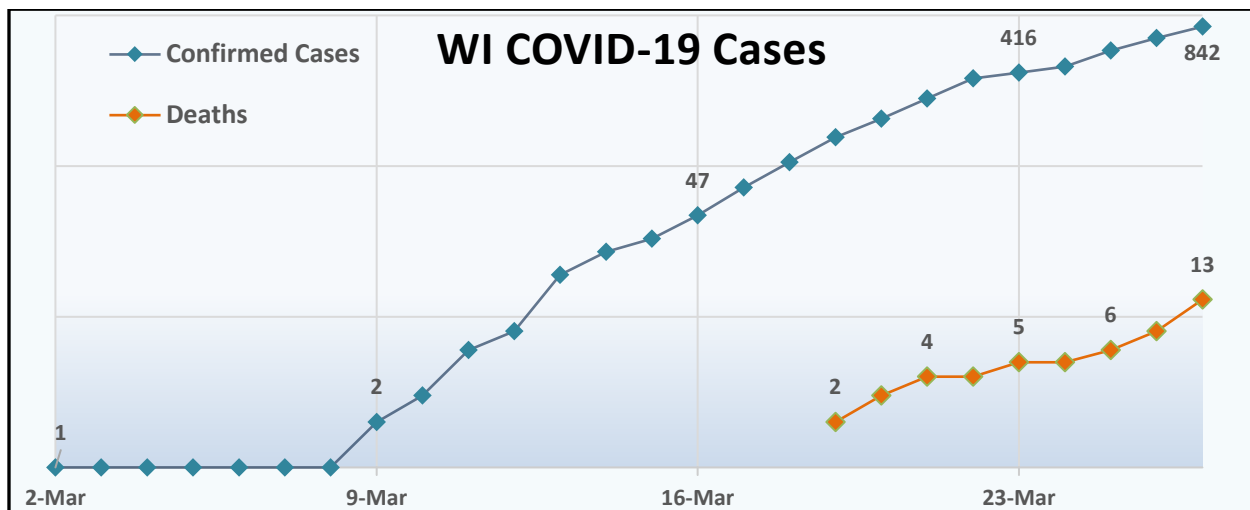

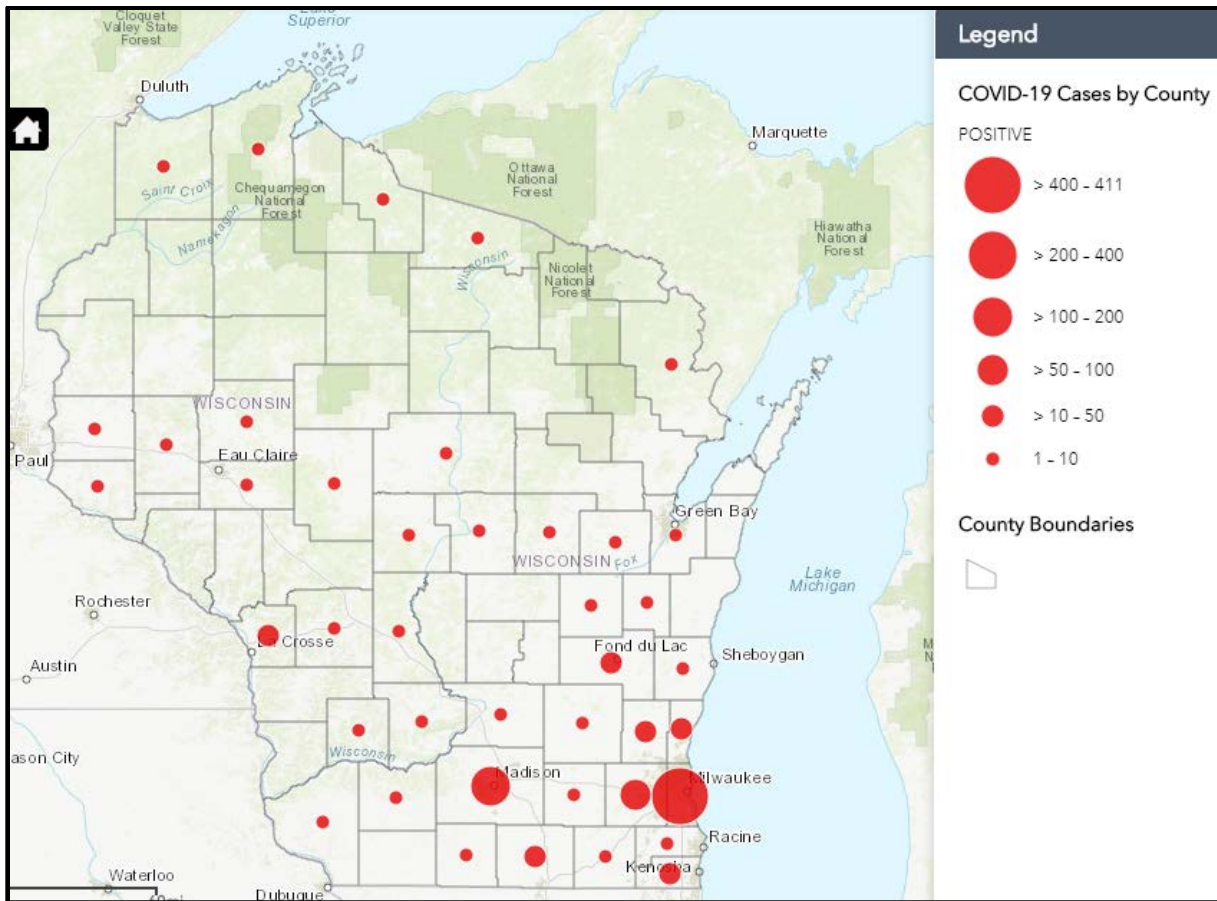

(U) Highlights

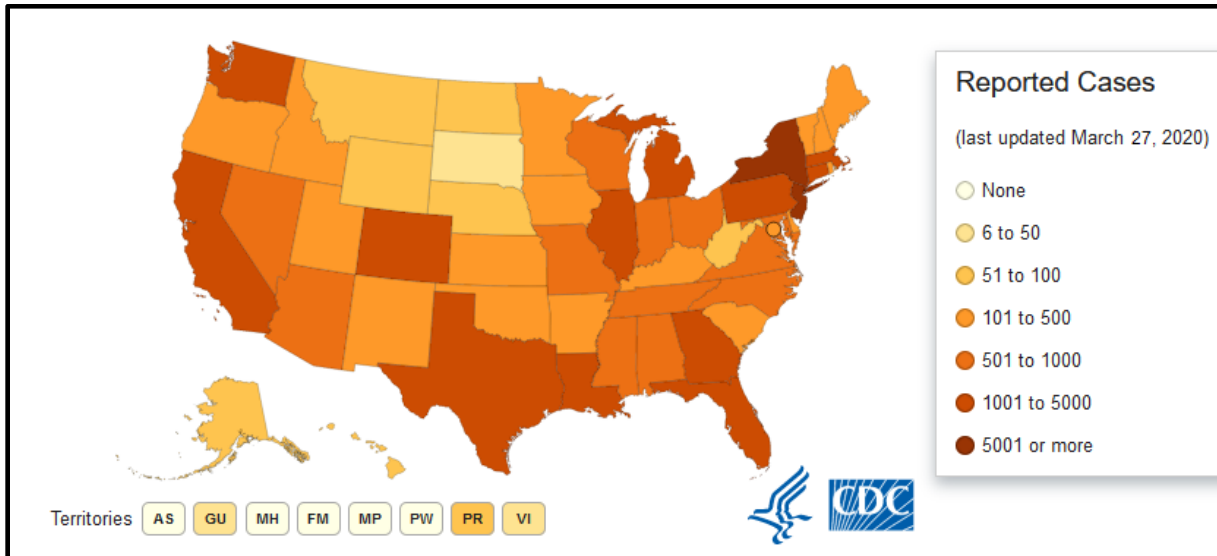
- (U) Village Pointe Commons in Grafton [reported](#) 2 more deaths from COVID-19, bringing the total at the facility to 3. **[TMJ4]**
- (U) Officials from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services noted more than [94% of coronavirus tests](#) have come back negative. This is in line with what public health experts expect at the beginning of a pandemic and have stated that they expect the number of positive tests to sharply rise soon. **[WPR]**
- (U) The Wisconsin Distillers Guild announced an estimated [75% of the state's distillers](#) have dedicated at least part of their production lines to making hand sanitizer. **[WPR]**
- (U) Chicago Mayor Lori Lightfoot ordered the city's [lakefront and adjacent parks closed](#), along with the 606 Trail and the Riverwalk. This is in response to residents not maintaining social distancing guidelines while outside in public areas. **[ABC Chicago]**
- (U) Roughly [36% \(519\) of COVID deaths](#) in the U.S. so far have occurred in New York state. **[Johns Hopkins]**
- (U) U.S. Government advises people who recently traveled from the N.Y. metro area to [self quarantine for 14 days](#) from the time they left due to a high COVID infection rate. **[Politico]**
- (U) The Governor of Louisiana warned that due to the surge in COVID-19 cases, hospitals in [New Orleans could run out of key medical resources](#), like ventilators, as early as 2 April. **[CBS News]**
- (U) Governments across the world are interested in rapid result [antigen tests](#), used to quickly determine if someone is infected with the coronavirus. However, Spain recently found that rapid tests it purchased were only about 30% accurate as compared to established lab tests that are 84% accurate. **[AP News]**
- (U) Indian authorities in the northern state of Punjab [quarantined](#) around 40,000 residents from 20 villages following a COVID-19 outbreak potentially linked to just one man at a religious festival who has known direct contact with at least 550 people. **[BBC]**

(U) Associated Threats & Mitigations

- (U) Shortages of ventilators from the surge of COVID-19 patients forced led to facilities and responders to consider other methods of helping people with breathing issues. However, officials and scientists [warn against](#) using positive airway pressure machines, like those used to treat sleep apnea over concerns these machines may increase the spread of infectious diseases by aerosolizing the virus. **[Kaiser Health News]**
