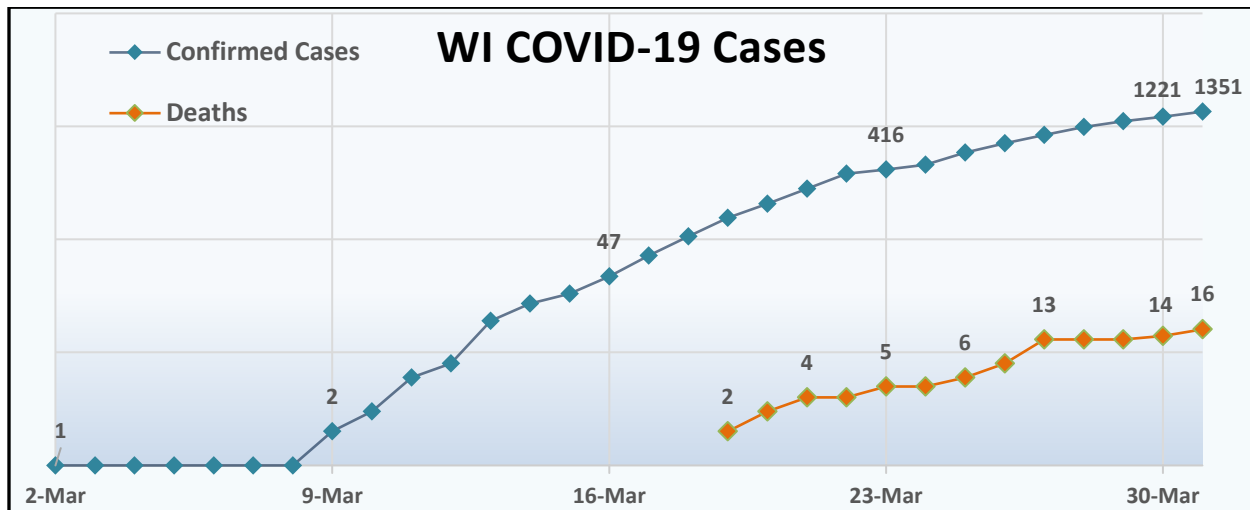

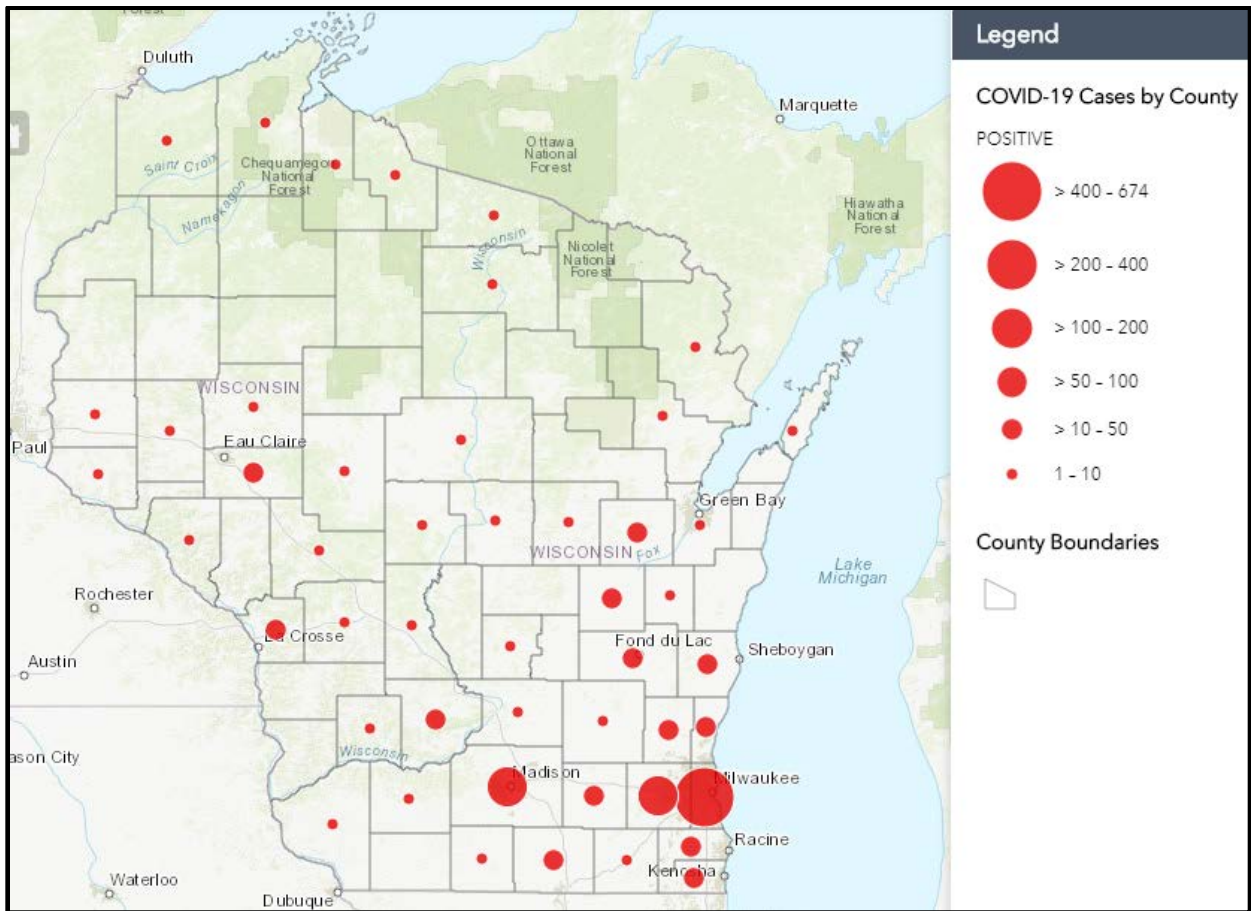

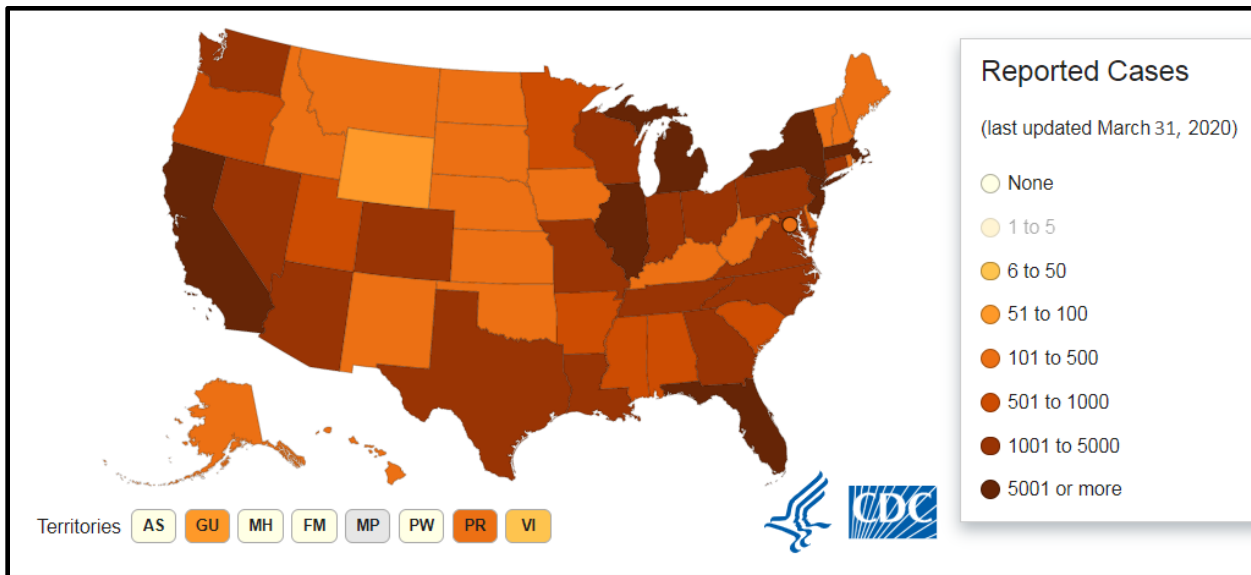
- (U) Kenosha-based clothing brand, [Jockey is donating](#) PPE to front-line doctors and first responders across the nation. Locally, the company is supplying the Kenosha Fire Department with 10,000 N95 masks and 10,000 Level 1 surgical masks. **[TMJ4]**
- (U) The Governor of Wisconsin [told reporters](#) that K-12 schools would remain closed until at least 30 April. **[TMJ4]**
- (U) UW-Madison reports that the university expects to [lose an estimated \\$100 million](#) because of the coronavirus pandemic. **[Wisconsin State Journal]**
- (U) The FDA authorized the emergency use of a [test that can detect the coronavirus](#) in nearly two minutes. **[Reuters]**
- (U) The FDA has granted [a full emergency use](#) authorization to Battelle for its mask decontamination machines that can clean N95 masks for reuse. The company has two machines each capable of cleaning 80,000 masks a day in Ohio and plans to deploy machines in New York, Seattle, and Washington D.C. **[USA Today]**
- (U) The Transportation Security Agency announced they screened the [fewest number of travelers](#) than any time in the past 10 years. Officers screened 154,080 people compared to over 2.3 million people on the same date in 2019. **[WTKR]**
- (U) Macy's, Kohl's, Gap, Gannett, and Sysco Corp. have all announced they [will be furloughing](#) hundreds of thousands of workers. **[Washington Post]**
- (U) China announced [more than 1,500 coronavirus](#) cases that were not previously public after having reported no new local cases for 2 weeks prior. The news has added to the questions about the accuracy of the numbers China has been reporting since the beginning of the outbreak. **[New York Times]**

(U) Associated Threats & Mitigations

- (U) With the rise of employers and people using video-teleconferencing (VTC) platforms to stay connected during the COVID-19 crisis, [reports of VTC hijacking](#) (also called "Zoom-bombing") are also emerging nationwide. The FBI recommends that people: do not make meetings or classrooms public, do not share links on unrestricted publicly available websites, managing screen sharing so only the "Host" can share, ensure users are using the updated version of remote access/meeting applications, and ensure that your organization's telework policy or guide addresses requirements for physical and information security. **[FBI]**
- (U) The U.S. Department of State, Global Engagement Center (GEC) advises U.S. citizens to be cautious about the sources of information they use to inform themselves. Malicious actors, including foreign countries, may [intentionally spread false information](#) through a variety of means including social media posts. **[U.S. Dept. of State]**
